

GUIDE TO BALLET 2018

Rehearsal Guidelines

- Please be prompt for arrival and pick up.
- Please have your child use the restroom upon arrival.
- Please put your dancer's name or initials on all personal belongings.

On the day of the show:

- Dancers are not permitted to exit the backstage area after check-in.
- Within a half hour of the start of our shows, the backstage area will be closed to dancers and volunteers only.
- All dancers need to remain through the second show finale.

Costume Guidelines

Please attend "parent watch" the week of April 3 to receive specific instructions on your dancer's costume.

On the day of the show:

- Ballet pink tights* with no runs or holes
- No visible undergarments
- No jewelry or nail polish
- All hair and make-up will be done upon arrival by Looking Good Salon

Sales: Tickets*, DVD*, and Flowers

- Tickets are sold at the ballet school and at the door on the day of the ballet

On the day of the show:

- Ticket sales begin a half hour before the shows

**We recommend pre-ordering your DVD and purchasing tickets and tights before or after your weekly class.*

Volunteers

Sign up for one of the following positions at the front desk of the ballet school.

1. Cookies – May be brought on Saturday's dress rehearsal or Sunday
2. Hair and Make-up - Our greatest backstage need is hair and make-up volunteers
3. Backstage Volunteer – Assist the designated class for the entire ballet in the dressing room area.
